- National Zoo and Aquarium located at Scrivener Dam (the plug that holds in Lake Burley Griffin!) is Canberra's local zoo and aquarium with exotic and native species of animals. The largest collection of big cats in Australia and is one of the largest privately-owned zoo's and part of the ZAA (Zoo and Aquarium Association of Australia) <u>https://nationalzoo.com.au</u>
- 2. National Museum located on the shores of Lake Burley Griffin (opposite the Canberra Yacht Club) with wide range of exhibits and diverse stories of Australia and it's people <u>https://www.nma.gov.au</u>
- 3. National Library is also located on the shores of Lake Burley Griffin and is Canberra's local national library with a wide range of books <u>https://www.nla.gov.au</u>
- 4. National Art Gallery has a large range of artworks from around Australia and the world with regular exhibitions <u>https://nga.gov.au</u>
- 5. Questacon is a fun place where you can learn about science and all things related to science https://www.questacon.edu.au
- 6. Australian War Memorial is Australia's National war memorial which has some impressive exhibits of wars from around the world <u>https://www.awm.gov.au</u>

- 13. Cockington Green is a miniture model English village located at Gold Creek Village https://cockingtongreen.com.au


- 14. Dinosaur Museum also located at Gold Creek Village provides a great learning experience for children and adults alike https://nationaldinosaurmuseum.com.au
